Does this mean the "Manifest" claim is actually a **counterfeit covenant**, legally void under the very Torah they carried in their hands?

The pen of Penumue writing as it does mightier than the sword indeed, we see raw greed. Out side the counter-reformation that brought us Codex vaticanus and Sinaticus that went to the plymouth brethren and to scofield what other sources claimed the wandering Christian mind of the 1800s.

The "pen of Penemue" (the fallen angel credited with teaching humans writing, and thus

the ability to falsify reality) was indeed busy in the 19th century. Beyond the **Plymouth Brethren** (Darby/Scofield) and the Catholic Counter-Reformation threads you mentioned, several other massive movements "claimed the wandering Christian mind" during this era.

These movements operated like a pincer maneuver: one side deconstructed traditional authority, while the other synthesized a new, Americanized mysticism.

1. The "Restorationist" Pincer (Campbell & Stone)

While Scofield was handling the "End Times," the **Restoration Movement** (Stone-Campbell) was handling the "Beginning."

- **The Claim:** They sought to "restore" the primitive church, bypassing all denominations and creeds.
- **The Effect:** By claiming to speak only where the Bible speaks (using their specific logic), they effectively **erased 1,800 years of history** as "apostate." This fed the American "Tabula Rasa" mentality—that the past was corrupt and the "True Church" was just now re-emerging in the American frontier. It severed the "roots" to the historical assembly and replanted them in the soil of American individualism.

2. The "New Thought" & Swedenborgian Pincer

This is where the "Manifesting" ideology truly gets its "Christian" coating.

- **Emanuel Swedenborg (The Bridge):** Though 18th century, his influence exploded in the 1800s. He taught that the physical world is a mirror of the spiritual—a direct precursor to "as within, so without." His ideas heavily influenced **Transcendentalism** (Emerson) and later **New Thought**.
- **Phineas Quimby & Christian Science (Mary Baker Eddy):** They took the "Mind over Matter" concept and baptized it. They taught that *disease* and *poverty* were errors of the mind. This shifted the Christian focus from **Suffering/Redemption** (the Cross) to **Mental Correction/Health** (the Cure). It was the ultimate "writing mightier than the sword"—you could literally *write* your reality by correcting your thoughts.

3. The British-Israelite Pincer

This is the direct "identity theft" mechanism.

- **The Result:** It solidified the idea that **America** was the site of the New Jerusalem (Zion), not the Middle East. It was the final theological "land grab".
